Getting Ready for September:

All our pupils have enjoyed at least one half-day session with their new class ready for September and all the teachers have conducted extensive hand-over meetings in order to be as prepared as possible for their new students moving up.

Here are just a few reminders of some important information for you and your child before we close next week and to ensure we are all ready for the new academic year:

- All reading books and library books need to returned by Wednesday of next week please.
- Please ensure all invoices are paid up to date by the end of next week.
- Class newsletters will be distributed and our class pages on the website will be updated
 in the first week back in September. This will provide lots of valuable information
 about the curriculum, homework (if relevant) and PE days;
- All pupils should continue to come to school in their PE kits every Friday and ensure full kit is stored in school all other days with exception of Reception.

- Only pupils in year 6 are permitted to bring in pencil cases from home containing some basic items. All required stationery is provided for all pupils in school.
- All pupils should bring a blue bookbag, a black PE bag, a water bottle and a lunchbox (if required). From September, children in years one up to year five are not permitted to bring rucksacks into school due to limited space in cloakrooms. For this year only, Year six are exempt from this arrangement.
- Please ensure that if your child is having their ears pierced during the holidays this is scheduled for as early as possible so that earrings can be removed for PE and for swimming lessons.
- All staff in school are in all-day training on both our Inset days on Monday 2nd and Tuesday 3rd September, therefore please email the office if you have anything urgent to share before the start of term, as staff are unlikely to be available on either day.

School finishes at 2pm on Friday 19th July and the final YoYo session of the year is available on Thursday 18th July until 5.15pm.

The new academic year starts on Wednesday 4th September for all pupils from 8.35am. Nursery sessions re-start the following Monday.

Please note that school will be closed on Thursday 12th September to allow families to attend the Westmorland County Show. This will be a training day for staff.
