# Parking at School:

Unfortunately, I have been receiving some complaints from our neighbours regarding people's lack of consideration when parking near our school at the start and end of the day.

Please may I politely remind everyone driving their children to and from school to:

• Avoid parking on grass verges, pavements or driveways;

- Do not turn around in the drives of the two houses opposite school on Church Road as this is private land.
- Do not park opposite 'School House' on Church Road, as this makes it very difficult for the residents to get in or out of their drive.
- Please do not park on pavements or across the drives of people living on the estate just across from our main entrance, Green Gate Gardens.

On occasions, parents/carers have also parked very close, if not across, the large wooden gates into our staff carpark. Please park well away from these gates as staff leave and enter this carpark at various times in the school day to go to meetings, training etc. Recently, staff have been unable to leave due to cars being parked partly or entirely in front of these gates.

Thank you in anticipation of your cooperation and understanding.

## Snow and Ice:

As we approach the colder months, please be careful on your journeys to and from school. Today has been particularly treacherous for those coming on foot as well as by car. We are very lucky that Michael is able to grit pathways in and out of school, but it is important that everyone takes great care – staying to the gritted areas and avoiding using any of the fixed playtime gym equipment.

If snow is forecast, please be aware that many of our staff travel considerable distances from all over Cumbria and Lancashire. Regardless of the weather conditions in Levens, it may be that staff are unable to get to school safely due to adverse weather either at home or along their journeys. In the unlikely event that we would have to close the school due to dangerous weather conditions, parents/carers would be notified via text as early in the morning as possible.
