Lunchtime and YoYo Support:

We will soon be advertising a position to support lunchtime supervision and our afterschool care at YoYo. If you are interested in joining the Levens team, or know someone who might be, in either or both of these positions, please do get in touch to arrange a meeting with me to learn more.

Uniform Expectations:

This is just a very polite, but important reminder about our expectations on uniform, particularly on Fridays where we are seeing an increased number of children coming to school in their own clothes. On Fridays, every child in school should be wearing their PE kits – this includes plain black or navy blue leggings, joggers or shorts; a plain or Levens pale blue or white t-shirt; and light blue PE Levens Hoodie. Branded, patterned, striped or coloured sportswear of any other description is not permitted. If your child does not wear the correct kit, they may be required to get changed into spare kit kept in school.

Parking Outside School and Road Safety:

We have been recently been contacted again by local residents. One resident this week narrowly missed some children who came running out onto Church Lane on Tuesday afternoon after Art Club at 4.15pm. If your child is permitted to leave our school gates unaccompanied, or ahead of whoever is supervising them, please do remind them of being extremely vigilant to traffic on both Church Road and Levens Lane. We have been reinforcing these messages in school too.

We are also really keen to remain on very positive terms with our neighbours so please park with consideration to our local residents and ensure your vehicle does not block pedestrian access by parking on pavements or obstructing driveways.

Staff News:

We are delighted to be welcoming Leah Manderson to our Class 1 team after half term in a teaching assistant capacity. Leah is already a mum at school and knows us all very well We know that she will become such a valued colleague, a great asset to the team and popular with children and families. I am sure you will want to join me in wishing her well in her new role.

Mrs Haslam will not be in school from Friday 28th February as she undergoes some scheduled surgery. She will be away from school for the remainder of the spring term, possibly longer. News about arrangements for teaching and learning in Class 1 for parents and carers will follow after the half term break. I am sure you will want to wish Mrs Haslam all the very best for a speedy recovery. Mrs Haslam's parent-teacher appointments will therefore be brought forward to the first week back after the half term break – details will follow very soon.

Fife/Flute Lessons:

I am keen to share that Sara Heath, a really super flute teacher, who has taught at Levens in the past, has been in touch to advise that she has some teaching capacity to offer us again, should there be an appropriate level of demand. She takes pupils from Year 3 and delivers tuition initially in shared small group lessons where costs range from £5.50 per week to £8 depending on participants and time allocated. Parents would initially need to purchase a fife which would cost around £11.

If you are interested, please email the office by Thursday 13th February, after which time we will be able to ascertain if the provision would be viable.
